- 2.) There are very limited spaces for extra vehicles near all sites. 1 vehicle per site strictly enforced. Additional vehicles, tow vehicles, and trailers will have to park away from the sites.
- 3.) **There are no club discounts for late arrivals (Tuesday-Saturday) and no refunds after June 30th, 2020.**
- 4.) Campground refunds are based on the refund policy of the campground you stay at and is solely between you and the campground.

****All adult registrants will be required to read and sign an event waiver before they participate in any Treffen activities. No exceptions!****

- Safety is always our #1 concern.
- Please observe the 5mph speed limit in the campground at all times.
- Please watch your children and pets.
- The Ouray can get cold even in the summer especially at night or during wet weather. In the summer, you will get rained on! Please bring adequate cold weather camping gear and outerwear. If you have medical problems that can be aggravated by the altitude, please try and moderate your exertion level.
- Bring plenty of bug spray!!!
- Drink plenty of water. Dehydration is a common cause of many illnesses at this altitude.
- In case of illness or injury, please notify a Treffen Host as soon as possible.

Trail rides: We will be doing trails of varying difficulty this year though most are **moderate to EXTREME**. Please study the lists of available rides and choose ones suited to your driving and your vehicle's ability. The Rocky Mountain Pinzgauers **are not responsible for damage to your vehicle or injuries sustained during our trail rides.** Trail ride descriptions and maps will be posted on the RMP website close to Treffen time.

Communications: If you don't have one, consider putting a CB radio in your truck or get a good quality CB portable. CB's are our primary way of communicating during trail rides & "convoy" style events and they will make your participation in the events more informative and enjoyable. We'll be using channel 4 for the entire event.

Well-behaved dogs and their responsible owners are welcome!

Campground Quiet time is 10 PM to 8 AM. Please be considerate of the other guests. This rule strictly enforced.
